NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, W.C. McDaniel
in the State aforesaid,
in consideration of the sum of Ten dollars and other valuable considerations
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

J.F. White
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

J.F. White, his heirs and assigns, All that lot of land situate on Henderson Street in City View, in the County and State aforesaid, fronting said St. 50 feet, and running back in parallel lines 150 feet, known and designated as Lot No. 82, in Block C., as shown by plat recorded in Plat Book A., page 460 and has such courses and distances as are shown on said plat. Also all that other lot of land in the same locality fronting McD. Street 50 feet, running back in parallel lines 150 feet, and is known and designated as Lot No. 99 in Block C., as shown by plat recorded in plat book A., page 460 and has such courses and distances as are there shown. Said two lots of land being among several conveyed to me by T.F. Hunt and others.

For value received, I hereby release and forever relinquish unto J.F. White, his heirs and assigns, so much of the land as is within described from the lien of a mortgage given to secure a note for \$600.00 by W.C. McDaniel the 8th, day of October 1917 and recorded in Vol. 59, page 128.
