(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said Dr. J. T. Smith, all of that certain piece, parcel and lot of land situate, lying

and being in the State and County aforesaid, Chick Springs Township, on the South East side of the New National Highway, and being a part of the same land conveyed to Mary J. Wood by W. P.
