in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Five Dollars and other goods and valuable consideration DOLLARS, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Annice Payne and Pearl McCarter

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said Annice Payne and Pearl McCarter,

All that certain piece or lot of land lying and being at the intersection of Augusta and Sullivan Streets, on the West side of Augusta Street and on the North side of Sullivan Street in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville aforesaid, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin 3 1/2 feet (5 ft.) north of the 3/4 of Sullivan Street on the edge of the present curb line of Augusta Street and bearing thence S. 89 1/2 W. two hundred (200 ft.) parallel with Sullivan Street five feet north of said line to an iron pin 3 1/2; thence N. 12 W. sixty feet (60 ft.) to an iron pin 3 1/2; thence N. 87 E. two hundred feet (200 ft.) to an iron pin at the curb line of Augusta Street, thence with the curb line S. 12 E. sixty feet (60 ft.) to the beginning corner, subject to the easement of said sidewalk and its now track and being the same lot of land conveyed to me by Annice Payne et al. by deed dated December 7th, 1911, and recorded in R.
