in consideration of the sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000) DOLLARS,  
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J. M. Paris of the State and  
County aforesaid

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said J. M. Paris his heirs and assigns, all that certain piece of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County and State aforesaid, on South Rutherford River being a part of a tract of land purchased by J. M. Paris for a lot in Downtown, and decided to sell by J. M. Paris on the 14th day of November A.D. 1915, adjoining Collins of J. C. Collins, M. H. Chastain, and J. M. Paris, and James to the following described boundaries: Beginning at the point in the Rutherford river where the Collins and Chastain meet; thence 16' 6" N. 68° 4' E. 12.28 chains to a point in road thence S 64° 44' 42" E. 11.16 chains to iron post, thence S 79° E. 2' 7" 42" to birch and river; thence along the river S 84° E. 5' 10" to the mouth of long branch, thence up the same to the head of said branch; thence S 85° 26' 15" to head thence S 64° 26' 45" to head thence S 62° 21' 45" to already thence S 65° 24' 45" to head thence S 71° 21' 45" to stake and branch, thence S 71° 04' 26' 20" to head, thence S 75° 54' 27" 30" to stake J.
