Kelly of the State and County aforesaid (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said L. M. Kelly all that piece, parcel and lot of land situate in this State and County aforesaid, near Brandon Valley, known as lot No. 44 in Block A, and part of the lands of McElveen Land Company recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds for said County in lot 13 of Vol. A, page 97, containing one acre and forty feet fifty and three feet wide, having a depth of one hundred and fifty feet on one side and one hundred and forty five feet on the other, bounded and having at the bottom a dwelling house thereon and being the same lot of land conveyed to me by T. V.
