(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said Thomas J. Earle

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, City of Greenville, on the northeast corner of North and Laurens streets, in said City of Greenville, beginning at a point corner of North and Laurens streets, and running thence in an easterly direction along North Street twenty-four (24) feet, more or less, to a point Cochrans corner, thence along Cochrans line, parallel with Laurens street, fifty (50) feet, more or less, to a point on Thomas's line; thence along Thomas's line, parallel with North Street, twenty-four (24) feet more or, to a point on Laurens Street; thence along Laurens Street fifty (50) feet, more or less, to the beginning corner, being the same lot of land conveyed to me, the said L.
