This contract made and entered into this 15th day of June 1918, between R. C. Willimow and Enore Power Company, witnesses as follows: The said R. C. Willimow and in consideration of the sum of \$100 in hand paid by the said Enore Power Company, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does grant unto the said Enore Power Company, its successors or assigns, the right and privilege to raise a dam on Log Shoals on Kedy River to such height as they or their successors or assigns may desire.

It is further agreed as part of this contract that should after the raising of such dam, the lands of the said R. C. Willimow become in any way injured or damaged by the water from backing by such dam as said Power Company may raise on said stream, the said Enore Power Company hereby binds itself, its successors or assigns, to pay the amount of such damage to the said R. C. Willimow heirs, executors, administrators or assigns. The amount of such damage, in case the parties hereto cannot agree upon the same, shall be arrived at and fixed in the following manner, to-wit:

The said R. C. Willimow heirs, executors, administrators or assigns, is to select one arbitrator, and the said Enore Power Company to select another, and these two arbitrators to select a third; if these two cannot agree upon such third arbitrator then he is to be selected by Clerk of Court; and if he will not make such selection, then such selection to be made by Probate Judge; and if he will not, then by Sheriff; and if for any reason arbitrators cannot be chosen, by a majority of them cannot agree, then the amount of such damage is to be determined by law. The award of said arbitrators shall be final and conclusive in determining the amount of said damage.

Known all men by these presents, that W. Tanner, J. H. Ballenger & J. R. Cole Trustees for Paris School, district No. 9, C. of said County and State, in consideration of the premises, and of the sum of \$400,000 Dollars to in hand paid by the City of Greenville South Carolina, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant unto the said City of Greenville, its successors and assigns, the right, privilege and easement to go in and upon that tract of land, situated in said County and State, bounded by lands of A. W. Green, on the North; A. W. Green on the East; Cole Estate on the South; and The Marsh Creek road on the West, and to construct and maintain in, upon, and through said premises, in a proper manner, with poles, towers, wires and other necessary apparatus and appliances, lines for the purpose of transmitting power by electricity and telephone service, together with the right at all times, to enter upon said premises for the purpose of inspecting said lines, and making necessary repairs, and alterations thereon, together with the right to cut away and keep clear of said lines, all trees and other like obstructions that may in any way and manner impede the proper operation of the same.

The payment above specified is accepted in full settlement of all claims for said easement. Any damages to crops planted shall be paid for at a price to be agreed upon, and if such sum not be arrived at mutually, the damage shall be determined by arbitrators, one to be chosen by the holder of this grant and the two so appointed, to select a third. The decisions of any two of the three arbitrators shall be final.
