Smith residing at the City and County of Salt Lake, State of Utah, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar and other valuable considerations to us paid by Corporation of the Presiding Bishop of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, a corporation sole, organized and existing under the laws of the State of Utah, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Corporation of the Presiding Bishop of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, the following described piece or parcel of land situate and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, to-wit:

Being situate about one mile west of the City of Greenville and near the Monaghan Mills, in a sub-division of land known as "New Hope", on corner of Hoyt and Miller Streets, and designated as Lot No. 1 on a plat of said sub-division, which plat is recorded in the office of Register of -

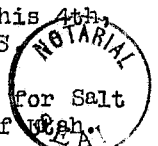
