Grayham of the County of Anderson in the State aforesaid (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said James L. Grayham all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about one and one half ($\frac{1}{2}$) miles west of the corporate limits of the City of Greenville known as lot number 42 on the plat of City View, recorded in Office of Register of Deeds for said County in Plat Book A, pages 460 and 461 having a frontage of fifty feet on Henderson Street with a depth of one hundred and fifty (150) feet to an alley, and being the same lot conveyed to me by W. Dodson (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said W. W. Dodson, his heirs and assigns, All that piece, parcel and lot of land situate, in the City and County of Greenville, South Carolina beginning at a stake on the west side of Falls Street, thence N. 71° W. 120 feet to a stake on an alley, thence with said alley S. 19° W. 68 feet to stake on an alley, thence S. 70° E. 120 feet to stake on Falls Street, thence along Falls Street to the beginning corner, being the same land conveyed to me by Mirriele Steele.
