KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Fred P. Abercrombie of the  
County of Greenvillein the State aforesaid,  
in consideration of the sum of  
Three Hundred  
to Two  
DOLLARS,  
in hand paid  
at and before the sealing of these presents by W. Carroll McDaniel(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release  
unto the said W. Carroll McDaniel,

All my undivided one-half interest in all that  
piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and  
being in South Carolina and in Greenville  
County, just beyond Woodside Mill, being known  
as Lot 6010 on a plat of Summit View in Block  
A, located on the Public Road and Goldfield  
Street, said plat as recorded in the R. M. C. Office  
for said Greenville County and State aforesaid  
in Plat Book "A" page 75, said lot has a frontage  
on the public road of fifty feet (50), for the  
other dimensions and metes and bounds see  
the above mentioned plat. This being the same  
lot conveyed to Ella J. Sheppard by A. Schouwelt  
by deed bearing date February 10th, 1913, said  
deed being recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville  
County in Deed Book 24, page 290, and said  
land being subsequently conveyed by said Ella  
J. Sheppard to L. C. Tripp by deed bearing date  
April 23rd, 1914. It being understood that said  
land herein described is conveyed subject to a  
mortgage for two hundred dollars (\$200.00) executed
