to Grover Brown in hand paid
at and before the sealing of these presents by Grover Brown

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Grover Brown

all that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, near the Town of Green, in Chick Springs Township, being part of lot No. 17 as shown by plat of the division of the Cunningham-Haywood-Burgiss made by W. H. Willis, C. E. on Dec. 10, 1915, being more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a stake at the intersection of the east margin of an unnamed street with the center of a fifteen foot alley and runs with the east margin of said unnamed street 8 1/2 degrees West 96 feet to a stake in the center of 15-foot alley, P. J. Johnson's line; thence with the center of said alley and Johnson's line in an eastern direction 55 feet to a stake in the line of lot No. 16; thence with the line of lot No. 16, N. 17 degrees East 80 feet to a stake in the center of the old alley; thence with the center of the old alley N. 56 Degrees 40 minutes West 55 feet to the beginning.
