(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Alvin H. Dean,

certain tract of land situate, lying and being in the County and State, aforesaid, and just beyond the corporate limits of the City, near the Rutherford Road, and East of said Road, and fronting on a street or lane, extending into said Road, containing one and $\frac{1}{2}$ acres, more or less, and adjoining lands now or formerly owned by Mrs. Eliza Bush, City Sullivan, Maria Rogers, and others. Said lot may be more accurately described by miles and bounds, courses and distances as follows: Beginning at a Stake 3. L. O.
