 to *J. L. Johnson* in hand paid
 at and before the sealing of these presents by *J. L. Johnson*

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release
 unto the said *J. L. Johnson*,

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land
 containing Sixty-Six and one-half (66 1/2) acres,
 more or less, according to a former Survey, and
 being all of that tract or parcel of land situate
 in *Grove Township, State and County* aforesaid,
 one witness of *Golden Grove Creek*, described
 as follows, to wit:

Beginning at a stone on the
 Greenville road; thence 26.55 E. 40.55 to a branch
 thence down the meanderings of said branch to a
 stone; thence S. 23 E. 16 1/4 to a stone; thence S. 48 E.
 N. 38.50 to a stone on the Greenville road; thence
 up said road N. 31 1/4 W. 24.75 to beginning
 corner and containing Ninety-one and one-half
 (91 1/2) acres, more or less.

Less, however, a tract of twenty-five (25) acres
 cut off from the above described tract and sold
 to *R. L. Eskew* by deed of conveyance by *J. H. Cobb*
 dated February 1st, 1913, recorded in the

 dated February 28th, 1914, Rec. 13 Books 28, page 249
 and being the same tract of land conveyed to
 me by *J. H. Dickson* by deed dated May 23rd,

 ville County in Vol. 28 at page 574.
