(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said B. E. Green, and his heirs and assigns, all that

certain piece, parcel or tract of land situated, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, and County of Greenville, in Austin Township, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a stone at Cross Road and running thence S. 00° W. 27.28 to a stone, thence S. 66° W. 50.1 to a stone, thence N. 78° E. 13.12 to a stone, thence N. 85° E. 12.05 to a stone, thence N. 24° E. 41 links to a red oak, thence down the branch with it as the line to a water oak, thence S. 66° W. 72 links to a stone, thence N. 82° E. 60 to a stone the beginning corner, and containing eighty-four and 7/100 acres, more or less, less thirty acres sold and conveyed therein by S. J. Fowler to S. P. Allison by deed dated the 10th day of Oct. 1910, and recorded in the R. M. C.
