KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I *Shos a King of Greenville*  
County,

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said *w. b. Verdin and J. S. Hamby their heirs* and assigns forever, all those two certain pieces, parcels and tracts of land situate in the State and County aforesaid and described as follows, to wit: - a certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate lying and being in Greenville County and State aforesaid on branch of Kilders Creek Branch waters of Saluda River beginning at stone in center of Factory Road 34, thence S.  $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 13.88 to a stone Chestnut gone 34, thence S. 68 E. 24.02 to a stone 34; thence N. 11 E. 8.00 to a stone on north side of Branch 34; thence N. 9 W. 12.16 to a stone on old line 34; thence N. 8 E. W. 10.19 to a stone 34; thence N. 94 W. 13.56 to the beginning stone, containing forty-two and one half  $\frac{1}{2}$  acres, lie the same more or less. Being the same tract of land conveyed to me by A. B. King by deed bearing date November 10th, 1899 and recorded in the Register of Deeds Conveyance Office for Greenville County in Vol. 333 page 74, also,

all that parcel or tract of land situate in the County and State aforesaid containing 68 sixty-eight and  $\frac{1}{2}$  acres more or less and known as the Son tract, being a part of the real estate of J. H. Smith, deceased, and delineated on a plat made by A. M. Dawson, Esq., abstract no. 1 and having the following lines and bounds: - Beginning on a stone at the corner of Bridge and running thence N. 15 E. 19.43 to a stone on ditch bank; thence S. 51  $\frac{3}{4}$  E. 17.60 to a stone near King's House; thence S. 5 W. 33.75 to a stone in Public Road; thence N. 16  $\frac{1}{4}$  E. 32.70 to a stone on ditch bank; thence N. 15 E. 3.20 to a stone on ditch bank; thence N. 34 E. 5.25 to a stone ditch bank; thence N. 13 E. 13.75 to a stone at bridge the beginning corner.
