(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said H.P. Sloan, all that certain parcel and tract of land situated and being in South Carolina, Greenville County, Highland Township and Middle Tyger River, having thereto belonging in meadow, forest, & water, beginning at a stake in center of Creek Lawrence Road, the 7th Kimney line, thence N. 83 $\frac{1}{4}$  E. 13.10 chains to a stone on Greenville-Spartanburg County line, thence S. 87 $\frac{3}{4}$  W. 17.70 chains to center of Middle Tyger River, thence down said river 22 chains to stone on west bank of said river, thence N. 88 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 23.80 chains on said County line, thence N. 86 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 3.10 chains to a stone in Lawrenceville Road, thence with said road N. 31 $\frac{1}{4}$  W. 10.31 chains to angle in road, thence N. 25 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 6.33 chains to angle, thence N. 33 W. 4.75 chains to the beginning corner containing sixty-two and one-fourth (62 $\frac{1}{4}$ ) acres more or less, said grantor reserving right of way over a strip fifteen feet wide from the Lawrenceville Road on the Southeast side of the above tract to Middle Tyger River for the purpose of locating a public road.
