at and before the sealing of these presents by Charles Brooks

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release
unto the said Charles Brooks, All my right, title and interest as heir of Matthew A. Griffith,

deceased, in and to that certain tract or parcel of land situate in the County of
Greenville, State of South Carolina, being a part of the estate of Matthew A. Griffith,
deceased, containing seventeen and one-fourth (17-1/4) acres, more or less, and having the
following lines, courses and distances according to plat made by W.A. Adams, Surveyor
March 29, 1917, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin on Maple Creek; thence due East 7.75
to an iron pin, corner of C.A. Brooks; thence along Brooks line N. 19-1/4 E. 7.83 to iron
