KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That We, H. Alex Griffith, B.T. Griffith, Elizabeth R. Taylor, Mary Ann Griffith, Hannah Frances Barnister, C. Oregon Sullivan and I. Keziah Jenkins, of the County of -

in the State aforesaid,

in consideration of the sum of

Six hundred five dollars and seventy-five cents (605.75) DOLLARS,

to US in hand paid

at and before the sealing of these presents by Charles Brooks.

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Charles Brooks, All our right, title and interest as heirs of Matthew A. Griffith,

deceased, in and to that certain tract or parcel of land situate, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being a part of the estate of Matthew A. Griffith, deceased, containing seventeen and one-fourth ($17\frac{1}{4}$) acres, more or less, and having the following lines, courses and distances, according to plat made by W.A. Adams, Surveyor March 29, 1917, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin on Maple Creek; thence due East 7.75 to an iron pin, corner of C.A. Brooks; thence along Brooks line N. $19\frac{1}{4}$ E. 7.83 to iron pin; thence along line of Stephen Brooks and lot conveyed by the heirs of Matthew A. Griffith to C.T. Scott, N. $37\frac{3}{4}$ E. $14\frac{1}{4}$ to a blackgum; thence S. $20\frac{1}{2}$ W. 22.03 along line of Mrs. Cox to a stone; thence S. $35\frac{3}{4}$ E. 1.54 to corner in Creek; thence up said Creek with the run thereof 6.25 to iron pin at beginning corner.
