KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, THAT I, Oscar Hodges, as executor of the just made and testament of Davis W. Hodges, by virtue of the power contained in said will and the second codicil thereto, and H. A. Hodges witness in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Sixty Two and ⁵⁰/₁₀₀ DOLLARS, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Davis W. Hodges.

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Davis W. Hodges,

All that piece, parcel, or tract of land, situate, lying and being in Saluda Township, County of Greenville, and State of South Carolina, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a stake on south side of "Hodges Mill Creek", corner of Humphrey's land; thence S. 48° E. 3.75 chains to a stake; thence S. 57° E. 6.10 chains to a stake; thence S. 28° E. 16.10 chains to the beginning corner; containing four and one-third (4 1/3) acres, more or less, and lying on both sides of the said "Hodges Mill Creek", on which is situated the "Shoal", and said Shoal being included and situated in said tract of four and one-third acres, and being the same tract of land conveyed to Davis W. Hodges, deceased, by Sarah A. Hodges, by deed dated July 29th 1901, and recorded in R. M. G. Office for Greenville County in deed book, Volume 168, on page 442.
