(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Mrs. Emma S. Reaves

All that certain tract or parcel land, situate, lying and being on the south side of Saluda River and west side of Mountain Creek in Franklin Township, County of Greenville, State aforesaid. Containing twenty nine and 75/100 acres more or less adjoining lands now or formerly owned by C. L. Ridgeway, Mrs. Harriet and Emma Ridgeway, H. H. Ridgeway, J. L. French, and Geo. A. Ridgeway.
