Four Thousand Two Hundred DOLLARS,  
to W. J. Monchard in hand paid  
at and before the sealing of these presents by W. J. Monchard

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release  
unto the said W. J. Monchard our heirs, executors and assigns:

All that certain tract of land, containing one hundred and  
fifty five acres, in the said more or less described as  
follows: Beginning at the Sunkilie Bridge Road with land  
belonging to formerly belonging to Mrs. Walford, thence N. 13°  
27'. 19.50 chains to a stone 3x3, thence N. 11° 45' 00" chains  
to a stake 3x3, thence N. 11° 45' 00" chains to a stone 3x3, thence  
N. 8° 10' 00" chains to a stake 3x3, thence N. 2° 45' 00" chains to a  
stone 3x3, thence N. 42° 00" chains to a stake 3x3 on Reedy River,  
thence down the meanderings of Reedy River to a stake 3x3  
(ash pointer) with tract No. 2 in division of land belonging  
to the estate of C. H. Ramsey, thence S. 48° 45' N. 26.80.00 w

aforesaid, for nearly the above named premises, very first day, and shall  
be under no compunction, charged or concerned in any manner what-  
ever.
