All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate lying and being in Grove Township, State and County aforesaid at Grove Station and having the following metes and bounds and courses and dimensions to wit:

Beginning at a stone near a spring and running thence N. 74 W. 7.25 to a stake 3x; thence S. 2 E. 5.85 to a stake 3x; thence S. 84 E. 4.25 to a stake 3x; thence N. 19 E. 5.15 to a stone 3x; the beginning named and continuing from acre, more or less than the remains lot of land conveyed to me by deed from R. L. Simpson bearing date and entered for record in office of Register of Deeds Lawrence for said County.
