unto the said *Elizabeth F. Ashmore*,

All that piece, parcel, or tract of land, lying,
being and situate in Grove Township, County and
State aforesaid, about nine and one half miles
South of the City of Greenville in the forks of
the Fork Shoals road and the Log Shoals roads,
and more fully described as follows, to wit:
