DEED TO J. B. Bruce, et al.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, W. A. Bates, of the City and County of Greenville,

in the State aforesaid,  
in consideration of the sum of Nine Hundred (\$900.00) —  
DOLLARS,  
to me  
in hand paid  
at and before the sealing of these presents by J. B. Bruce and Mrs. A. White

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said J. B. Bruce and Mrs. A. White, and their heirs and assigns forever.

All those two (2) certain parcels or lots of land situate in County and State aforesaid, known as lots Nos. 11 and 12 in the plat of Survey of the lands of which Martha J. Howell died seized and possessed, made by W.A. Adams on the 15th day of March, 1914, and having the following notes and bounds to wit:

Lot No. 11: Beginning at a red oak on \_\_\_\_\_ street, corner of Lot No. 12; thence along said street S. 9 E. one hundred and eighteen (18) feet to a stake; corner of lot No. 10; thence N. 67 1/2 E. two hundred and ninety (290) feet to a stake; thence N. 9 1/2 W. eighty-six and one-half hundred and eighty-two and one-half (282 1/2) feet to the beginning corner, containing sixty-five one hundredths (.65) acres, more or less;

Lot No. 12: Beginning at a red oak on \_\_\_\_\_ street, corner of lot No. 11; thence along line of lot No. 11 N. 73 1/2 E. one hundred and forty-one (141) feet to a stake; thence N. 13 W. three hundred and ten (310) feet to a stake; thence N. 8 1/2 W. one hundred forty-one (141) feet to a stake; thence N. 13 E. three hundred and ten (310) feet to the beginning corner; containing one (1) acre, more or less;

Plat of the above property recorded in Plat Book C, pages 154, and 155, and being the same two tracts of land conveyed to me by J. W. Gray, Master, by deed dated the 17th day of May 1914.
