(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Lorraine Huff, and I. B. Bradley, all of our several interest in all that certain tract, parcell or tract of land situate lying and being in the State and County aforesaid containing (66 2/3) sixty-six and two thirds acres, be the same or more or less, bounded by lands of W. S. Turner of Thomas Bridges, and tract #4 being tract #5, of a certain parcell or tract of land, deceased to W. A. Bradley, deceased by Josephine Bradley, I. B.
