(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release
unto the said M. O. Dunbar, his Heirs and assigns,

all that lot of land situate on the South
side of Buncombe Street in the City and
County of Greenville, S.C. beginning at the
corners of this lot and lot no. 4 on Buncombe
Street, and running thence S. 56 W. one hundred
and fifty feet to an iron pin, corner of
this lot and lot no. 4; thence N. 34 W. Sixty
feet to an iron pin; thence N. 56 E. One hundred
and fifty feet to an iron pin on Buncombe
Street, thence along Buncombe Street S. 34 E.
Sixty feet to the beginning corners being
the same land conveyed to me by W. H.
Balentine by deed dated the 11th day of
June 1917, and recorded in Vol. 46 at page
334.
