(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said W. C. Nesbitt and W. C. Nesbitt, their heirs and assigns, all that piece, parcel or tract of land situate on the Pendleton or White Horse road in Greenville Township near the Farmers Oil Mill on the North side of said road containing five and 6³/₁₀₀ acres said tract of land having the following lines and bounds to wit: Beginning at an iron pin 3 ft on said Pendleton Road at A. E. Folger's corner and running thence with said Folger's line N. 33-1/3 E. 4.58 chains to an iron pile 340 m; thence S. 81-1/2 E. 3.30 chains to an iron pin 371 m in a ditch in A. E. Folger's line, thence down ditch as a line N. 45-1/4 E. 2.80 chains to a bend in the ditch, thence N. 45-1/4 E. 1.81 chains to stake 370 m to S. W. Seydel's line in a road iron pin for small White Oak 343 m, thence along said road N. 27 W. 6.50 chains to an iron pile 371 m, iron pin 371 m on the Pendleton road, thence along said road 1.58 chains to the beginning corner, Being the same lot of land conveyed to me by George M. Col by deed dated the 29th day of December, 1910 and recorded in the R. P. C. Office for this County in Volume 9, page 40.
