(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said L. S. Hamby his heirs and assigns forever

A certain piece parcel or tract of land situate lying and being in Greenville County and State aforesaid on Branch of Miller Creek Branch waters of Enore River - Beginning at stone in center of Factory Road by thence S. 4 1/2 N. 13.88 to a stone chestnut pole 37; thence S. 68 E. 27.02 to a stone 37; thence N. 11 E. 8.00 to a stone on North side of Branch 37; thence N. 9 N. 12.16 to a stone on old line 37; thence N. 8 E. 10.19 to a stone 37; thence N. 77 W. 13.56 to the beginning stone, containing forty two and one half acres to the same more or less. Being the same tract of land conveyed to Thos. A. King by A. B. King by deed bearing date November 16th 1897 and recorded in the Register Messng Conveyance Office for Greenville County in Vol. T.S.S. page 74 and conveyed by the said Thos. A. King to H. F. Seardin and L. S.
