(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said *George Brownlee his heirs & assigns forever,*

All that certain piece parcel of lot I had  
 situated, lying and being in the City of Greenville  
 County of State, aforesaid, on the west side of  
 Augusta, S.C. and described as follows. Beginning  
 at an iron post at Mrs. Charles Cornell's Augustan  
 Street, and running thence with Mrs. Charles  
 Cornell's 74-15 feet 200 feet to a stake; thence
