 unto the said *B. H. Cook his heirs and assigns forever*,

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land
 situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville
 and State of South Carolina, and having the
 following metes and bounds to wit: as shown on plat
 made by Mr. Adams on Oct. 28, 1811. Beginning at iron
 post set what is known as the "Perkins Road" and
 running thence N. 62 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 16.15 with Luther M. Bees
 line to stone; thence N. 46 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 11.10 to stone and iron
 line on corner of Dick Jamison's land; thence with his
 line N. 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 14.83 to stone and iron iron corner of
 Julius Babbs land; thence with Babbs line S. 78 W.
 35.50 to iron iron iron corner of land belonging to the
 estate of Wister Blight; thence S. 15 $\frac{1}{4}$ E. 24.93 to the
 beginning corner, containing 53.07 acres more or less and
 being the same tract of land conveyed to me by *B. H. Cook* by deed dated February 1st 1817, and recorded in
