unto the said *T. M. Stokes*

all that certain piece, parcel and tract of land situate  
lying and being in the State and County aforesaid  
on the East side of the Rutherford Road, on Cooley's  
Beaver Dam Creek, adjoining lands of G. W. Neely,  
W. H. Stokes estate, J. J. Stokes, Clin Field,  
J. A. Forester and others, and being the same land  
conveyed to me by J. E. Page and H. C. Stokes by  
deed bearing date of July 20th, 1891, and by John  
J. Forester, by deed bearing date of Nov. 25th, 1895,
