Brown and Mattie S. Barton, and being a part of the land of which the said P. D. Gilreath died seized and possessed, with lines beginning on said Road on a corner of said Perry W. Brown and the said Langford running thence n. 75 1/2 W. fifteen chains to a stake on a corner of said Langford and Mattie S. Barton thence S. 5 1/4 W. five and one half chains to a stake corner of said Mattie S. Barton and Perry W.
