KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That

I, S. O. Skelton

in the State aforesaid,
 in consideration of the sum of
 Ten Dollars and other valuable Consideration DOLLARS,
 to me in hand paid
 at and before the sealing of these presents by T. M. Morris.

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

T. M. Morris

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land
 situate, lying and being in the County and
 State aforesaid, City of Greenville, on the south-
 west side of Augusta Street, and having the following
 metes and bounds according to plat of property
 of S. O. Skelton by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, dated August
 29, 1919, to wit:

Beginning at a stake on the southwest side of
 Augusta Street 111.8 feet from the intersection of
 Augusta Street and ^{Upper} Street, joint corner of S. O. Skelton
 property and running thence with Skelton property
 S. 83° 54' W. 228 feet to an iron pipe; thence, with
 Skelton property, S. 5-10 E 68.4 feet to a stake on prop-
 erty of R. J. Williams; thence with Williams property
 S. 88-47' E 246.2 feet to an iron pipe on Augusta Street;
 thence with Augusta Street N. 16-44' E 57 feet to
 a stake; thence still with Augusta Street N. 11-18' E.
 47 feet to the point of beginning.

Subject, however to the following restrictions,
 which is a part of the consideration for this deed:
 That no building shall be erected on above de-
 scribed lot within ninety feet of the present line of
 Augusta Street, or in close proximity with the residence of
 S. O. Skelton and R. J. Williams.
