certain piece, parcel or lot of land situated, lying and being
in Ward Five of the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid,
on M^{rs} Call Street and being described as follows to wit:
Beginning at a point on M^{rs} Call Street 150 feet from
the intersection of M^{rs} Call and Calhoun Streets and running
thence with M^{rs} Call St. in a northwesterly direction Fifty
(50) feet to a stake; thence in a straight line, parallel to
and 100 feet from Calhoun Street, One Hundred (100) feet
to a stake midway between M^{rs} Call and Wave Streets; thence
in a southeasterly direction, parallel with M^{rs} Call Street,
