in consideration of the sum of

at and before the sealing of these presents by J. L. Caldwell

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

J. L. Caldwell, all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate
lying and being in the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina,
on both sides of the Greenville and Rutherfordton Road and being
designated tract no. 1 of the T. J. Earle Est. as shown on Plat made
by W. N. Willis, July 3rd, 1919, and having the following metes and
bounds to-wit: Beginning at a stone in old Rutherfordton
Road and running thence with said road N. 2. 07 W. three hundred
thirty-eight (338) feet to bend in said road; thence continuing with
said road N. 3. 34 E. two hundred fifty-eight (258) feet to bend
in road; thence continuing with said road N. 3. 45 W. two-hundred
twenty-six (226) feet to the corner of tract no. 2; thence with
the line of tract nos. 2 and 3 S. 86 E. Eleven hundred and Eighty
(180) feet to a stone; thence S. 340 W. Eight hundred and Eight
(808) feet to stone; thence N. 84. 25 W. Six hundred and Sixty-one
(661) feet to a stake; thence S. 84. 05 W. four hundred and forty-
eight (448) feet to the beginning corner and containing thirty-
one and five-tenths (21.5) acres more or less. Also, all that
other certain piece, parcel or tract of land, situate, lying and
being partly in Greenville County, partly in Spartanburg
County, State of South Carolina and known and designated
as tract no. 6 of the T. J. Earle Est. as shown on Plat made by W. N.
Willis, July 3, 1919, and having the following metes and bounds
to-wit: Beginning at the joint corners of tracts nos. 5, 6, 7 and
8 and running thence with the line of lot no. 8 S. 87. 30 E.
One thousand and Seventy-four (1074) feet to corner on Goosell
land; thence with the line of Goosell land S. 4. 10 W. one thousand
five hundred and twenty-five (1525) feet to an iron pie;
thence S. 30 E. two hundred and Seventy (270) feet to the
Goosell road; thence with said road S. 74. 40 W. two hundred
and Sixty (260) feet to bend in said road; thence continuing
with said road S. 65. 30 W. One hundred and forty (440)
