KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That

J. C. W. Cox

in the State aforesaid,
 in consideration of the sum of
Tens (\$10.00) Dollars and other Valuable Consideration DOLLARS,
 to me in hand paid
 at and before the sealing of these presents by J. M. Cox

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

J. M. Cox. All my right, title and interest
 being an undivided one-half interest in and to
 all that certain tract of land situate in the
 County and State aforesaid and known and
 designated as tract #1 of the lands of P. F. Cox
 as shown on plat made by W. A. Adams
 Feb. 2 1917 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office
 for Greenville County Plat Book E, page 62 and
 having the following lines and bounds to wit:-
 Beginning at an iron Pipe in the center of the
 Fork Shoals Road and running thence with the
 center of said road S. $23\frac{1}{2}$ E. 8.65 chains to stake;
 thence S. $82\frac{1}{2}$ E. $3\frac{1}{4}$ chains to stake; thence N. $2\frac{3}{4}$
 W. 7 chains to stone; thence N. $53\frac{3}{4}$ W. 27.90 chains
 to stone in center of road; thence with center line
 of said last mentioned road S. $54\frac{1}{2}$ W. 3.36 chains
 to an iron pin; thence still with center of said
 road S. $53\frac{3}{4}$ W. 15.06 chains to the beginning corner
 containing 52.65 acres, more or less, and being
 a portion of the lands conveyed to J. M. Cox and
C. W. Cox by E. Danner, master by Deed recorded
 in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County Vol. 40, page 38.
 This is a deed in partition, another tract of
 equal value, in which the said J. M. Cox and
 myself are equally interested, being allotted to
 myself and being conveyed, as a matter
 of convenience by the said J. M. Cox and
 myself to miss. Leila M. Ashmore, to whom
 I sold it after it was so allotted to me.
