(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said S. F. Bailey, all that piece, parcel and tract of land situate lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, on both sides of Mt. Graham Creek, Waters of South Saluda River, containing Two hundred and fifty five acres, more or less, and having the following lines, metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a stone 37 m on old line, and running thence N. 31 $\frac{3}{4}$ E. 41.80 to a Hickory 37 om. Thence 19 $\frac{2}{3}$ W. 32.50 to a black gum 37 om. Thence S. 24 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 15.40 to a small pine 37 (once small asazia) Thence N. 88 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 17.15 to a rock 37 om. (Henry Evans Spring) Thence 45 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 33.05 to a chestnut 37. Thence S. 41 E. 27.00 to a stone 37 om. Thence S. 20 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 12.68 to a red oak 37 om. Thence N. 54 E. 25.37 to the beginning corner, being the same tract of land conveyed by D. J. Beyne, Master, of Greenville County to G. A. Norwood by his deed bearing date Oct. 3rd 1885, and in said deed described by metes and bounds, as above described, and after the death of the said G. A. Norwood, conveyed to me by all the heirs at law of the said G. A. Norwood, being conveyed to me by them both as Trustee and individually, said deed being recorded in R. M. C. Office in Book F O.P. 395.
