KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, L. D. Patterson, of the City and
County of Greenville

in the State aforesaid,
in consideration of the sum of
Three hundred Dollars (\$300.00), DOLLARS,

to me in hand paid
at and before the sealing of these presents by George H. Davidson and Mrs Eva May
Davidson

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

George H. Davidson and Eva May Davidson and
their heirs and assigns all that certain lot
piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being
in the State of South Carolina in the County and
Township of Greenville, a short distance west or north-
west of the corporate limits of the City of Greenville
and West of a subdivision known as Park Place,
near the Bands of American Spinning Company and
F. W. Gee Manufacturing Company, known and design-
ated as lot No. ten (10) according to a survey made
for said L. D. Patterson by the late William W. Hudson,
and having according to such survey the following
metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a stake
on the south west side of Silreath Street, on the
north corner of a lot conveyed by said L. D. Patterson
to the said George H. Davidson by deed recorded
in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyances
for said County and State in Deed Book 41,
page 613, and running thence along line of said
lot S. $21\frac{1}{3}$ ° W. one hundred and eighty one (181) feet
and eight (8) inches to a stake on a ten foot alley;
thence along said alley N. $68\frac{7}{18}$ ° W. seventy (70) feet
more or less, to a stake on Goldsmith Street;
thence along Goldsmith Street N. $21\frac{1}{3}$ ° E. one hun-
dred and eighty (68) feet to a stake on the corner
of Goldsmith and Silreath Streets; thence along
Silreath Street S. $69\frac{1}{2}$ ° E. seventy (70) feet, more
or less, to the beginning corner, this being form-
erly known as lot No. 46 of the Hammett lands
according to a plat thereof made by William F. Lee,
dated July 3, 1913, and being a portion of the land
conveyed to me, the said L. D. Patterson by James
F. Orr, Executor of the will of H. P. Hammett, deceased,
by deed executed January 10, 1905, and recorded in
said office in Deed Book N. 92 N. page 495.
