KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That

B. J. Coleman

in the State aforesaid,
 in consideration of the sum of
Ten dollars and other good & valuable Consideration,
 to me Dollars, in hand paid
 at and before the sealing of these presents by A. A. & C. A. Jamison

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

A. A. & C. A. Jamison, their heirs and assigns; all that certain piece parcel and tract of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, on the waters of Enoree River and having the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at a large white oak, 3x; and running thence with Mrs. C. A. Brice's line a certain distance to a small red oak, 3x; thence in a straight conundinary line to a large black gum, 3x, on the creek (formerly the corner between Mrs. Mays and Mr. Cartee) thence down said creek following the course of the creek to a stone 3x, opposite the beginning corner, thence to the white oak, the beginning corner 20 3/4 Acres. More or less, also all that other piece parcel and tract of land, situated, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid and having the following metes and bounds to wit: beginning at a white oak 3x, thence N. 31³/₄ E. 12.40 chains to a rock 3n; thence S. 27 W. 19.36 chains to a R. O. T. O. Thence N. 62 E. 10.30 chains to the beginning corner, containing ten and 8/10 (10.8) acres, more or less, and being the same two tracts of land conveyed to me, the said B. J. Coleman by Alice Bowers Childs by her deed dated March 7th 1910 and recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in vol. 34, 549.
