

Gertrude Harrison DEED TO W.P. Chiles

STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,

COUNTY OF Greenville

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I Gertrude Harrison

in the State aforesaid,

in consideration of the sum of Ten dollars & other valuable consideration DOLLARS,

to me in hand paid

at and before the sealing of these presents by W.P. Chiles

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

W.P. Chiles all that tract of land in 8<sup>th</sup> Ant<sup>h</sup> Township Greenville County, South Carolina, on the Augusta and Fork Shoals Road, about five miles from Greenville Court House, known as, a part of the Jones Place:

Beginning at a cross in a large rock on bank of Reedy River, thence by a new line S. 62-15 W. 5-69.5 feet to iron pin 1; thence by a new line N. 83-15 W. 5-39.5 feet to iron pin in an old pond dam; thence S. 73-15 W. 7-17.5 feet to an iron pin; thence by a new line S. 6-45 E. 5-42.2 feet to an iron pin in edge of plantation road; thence with the road as a line S. 87-48 W. 4-66.3 feet to a bend; thence S. 66-48 W. 5-15.5 feet to a bend in said road; thence S. 68-13 W. 3-24.5 feet to an iron pin in center of plantation road and Augusta road; thence with Augusta Road S. 3-54 E. 10-48 feet to a bend in Fork Shoals Road; thence with Fork Shoals Road S. 5-30 E. 19-4.6 feet to stone on bank of said road, corner of Mrs. Ayda Morgan's property; thence with Mrs. Ayda Morgan's line N. 5-90 E. 3-74.6 feet to stake on Reedy River; thence with the meanders of said river 7-99 feet to the beginning containing 88.43 acres, more or less, according to survey of R. C. Daltow under date of December 3-<sup>th</sup> 1910.
