All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the west side of Buncombe Street in Ward One of the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, and having the following metes and bounds as shown on plat made by R. E. Dalton Nov. 1919, to wit: - Beginning at an iron pipe on Buncombe Street corner of Dr. J. G. Currie's lot and running thence with Buncombe Street N. 32° 06' W. 71 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 56° 35' W. 43 feet to an iron pipe; thence N. 33° 25' W. 4 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 56° 35' W. 31 feet to an iron pipe; thence N. 68° 25' W. 2.5 feet to an iron pipe; thence N. 33° 25' W. 12.35 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 56° 35' W. 4.5 feet to iron pipe; thence S. 33° 25' E. 6 feet to iron pipe; thence N. 68° 25' W. 11.2 feet to iron pipe; thence S. 23° 20' W. 157 feet to fence post; thence S. 69° 55' E. 40.5 feet to fence post; thence N. 48° 30' E. 69.7 feet to iron pipe; thence N. 39° 46' W. 15 feet to iron pipe; thence with the line of Dr. J.
