(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

S. D. Knight, all that certain piece, parcel and tract of land lying, being and situated in Fairview Township, County & State aforesaid, bounded by lands of A. Huff, P. L. Huff, Henry Durant & others, and having the following mates and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a stone in branch P. L. Huff's corner and running thence down branch N. 79 $\frac{1}{4}$ W. 36 $\frac{1}{2}$ to white oak on branch at head, thence 1.23 to bend in branch, thence S. 73 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 6.40 to bend in branch; thence S. 21 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 1.30 to center of branch, thence N. 85 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 1.45 to center of road, thence S. 52 $\frac{1}{4}$ W. 7.29 to iron pin in road, thence N. 89 $\frac{1}{4}$ W. 9.70 to an Oak Bush, thence N. 84 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 6.37 to a stone, thence S. 79 $\frac{1}{4}$ W. 1.37 to a Black Gum on branch, thence down branch 17.07 to a Hickory 27, thence S. 74 $\frac{3}{4}$ W. 18.00 to center of river (Reedy) thence up center of said river to a point in center of river, Augustus Huff's corner, thence N. 53 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 32 $\frac{1}{2}$ to a stone 38, thence S. 59 $\frac{3}{4}$ E. 28.25 to a stone, P. L. Huff's corner, thence S. 38 $\frac{7}{8}$ W. 13.25 to the beginning corner, containing one hundred nineteen and $\frac{3}{10}$ (119.3) acres, more or less, according to plat of a survey made by J. A. Adams Feb. 3, 1910, and being the whole of two tracts of land conveyed to me by L. L. Richardson by deed dated Dec. 27 Ind 9, 1905, 3d and recorded in the office of R. M. C., Book D at p. 204, the other conveyed to me by L. L. Richardson by deed dated Jan 8th, 1910, and recorded in the office of R. M. C. for Greenville in Book 6 at p. 245.
