KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Mary M. C. Ray Sheppard, formerly
Mary A. M. C. Ray, now of Brushybrook¹ in the State of Pennsylvania,

Five Thousand dollars and other valuable considerations,
to me in hand paid
at and before the sealing of these presents by John T. Woodside, J. D. Woodside, Robert D.
Woodside & E. F. Woodside.

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said
John T. Woodside, J. D. Woodside, Robert D. Woodside and
E. F. Woodside, all of the City and County of Greenville
and State of South Carolina, their heirs and assigns,
all that piece, parcel and lot of land, situate, lying
and being in the City and County of Greenville, in the
State of South Carolina on the East side of Main Street,
and between M. C. Bee Avenue and Washington Street,
said lot fronting fifty feet on Main Street and running
through to Brown Street, adjoining lot of W. C. Cleveland
on the South, and lots of J. T. Woodside, J. D. Woodside,
Robert D. Woodside and E. F. Woodside and Hovey Smith
on the North, and being fifty feet on Brown Street, Being
the same lot conveyed to me, under my maiden name
of Mary A. M. C. Ray, by James P. Boyce, Treasurer of the South-
ern Baptist Theological Seminary by deed dated the
