Mrs. M. A. Lister, the following described real estate, to wit;
All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, lying, being and
situate in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in what
is known as the "Park Place" near the City of Greenville, a
revised plat of which is on record in the R. M. C. Office for
the County of Greenville, in the State of South Carolina, in
Plat Book "A" at page 119, said lot being number nine (9)
on said revised plat, in Block "M", and being the same lot
of land conveyed to J. B. Terns by deed of Charles W. Hopkins by
J. G. Donaldson his attorney in fact, and bearing date of January
30th, 1911, and recorded in Office of R. M. C. in Vol. 6 at page
352, and being the same conveyed to me by J. B. Terns by
deed dated August 7th, 1914, and recorded in office of R. M. C.
in Vol. 26 at page 402.

and situate in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina
in what is known as Park Place" near the City of Green-
