(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

Wm G. Serrine, and his heirs and assigns, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate lying and being in Greenville County State of South Carolina, about two miles West of Greenville Court House, and being lot # 143 and half of lot no. 142 of a subdivision known as "City View" Beginning at a stake on M.D. Ave. one hundred feet from New Cut Road, same being joint corners of lots nos. 143 & 144 in running thence N. 89 1/2 W. 150 feet to a stake on a ten foot alley, thence N. 1/2 E. 75 feet to a point on line of alley, being half of lot no. 142, thence S. 89 1/2 E. 100 feet to M.D. Avenue to a point being half of lot no. 142, thence S. 1/2 W. on line of M.D. Ave. 75 feet to the beginning corner, as shown by a plat of the City View made by W.
