(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

Andrew P. Hawkins

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in Greenville County, Oaklawn Township, State aforesaid and containing Nineteen acres, more or less, and having the following bounds and metes: Beginning on the Grove Station Road between Pelzer and Grove Station at a stone 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>; thence 5° 2' E. 9' to stone 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>; thence S. 64° W. 12' 25" to a stone 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>; thence up the Grove Road to the beginning corner. The above contains three and one-half acres sold by E. L. Seagren to Smith. This tract was formerly conveyed to C. C. Wilson by W. A. Simpson, and to the latter by J. O. Morris by deed dated Dec. 1, 1906.

Also that other piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, adjoining the above on the East side of the Pelzer Road and containing three and one-half acres, more or less: Beginning on the Grove Road at Mrs. B. S. Owen's corner, thence Little Mrs. Owen's line 6° 5' 0" S. 0° E. 7' 0" to a pine; thence N. 2° 5' 0" 45' W. 7' 0" ch. to the corner of the public road 2° 5' 0" 45' E. to the beginning corner. These two lots are the same lot due to C. C. Wilson by J. A. C. Lindley. The same will show on record at Greenville Court House.

Also all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land known as lot No. 3, lying on the East side of the Grove Road, and being a part of the tract of land belonging to the late husband of S. W. Anderson conveyed to her estate by his last will and testament, which was duly probated at Anderson Court House, the said lot containing three-fourths of an acre, more or less: Beginning at a stone on the Grove and Greenville Road on Mrs. Owen's corner, thence N. 52<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> east 20'; thence N. 37<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> West 3' 50" thence S. 5. 2. 0 West 23', thence 54<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> E. 35' 2" to the beginning corner.

The above described tracts of land were all conveyed to W. A. Simpson by C. C. Wilson by deed dated February 19, 1913, recorded March 18, 1913, in R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 19, at page 26.

These being the same tracts of land conveyed to H. P. Mc Gee as Trustee, by E. Inman, Master, by deed dated March 9th, 1916, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County on March 19th, 1916 in Vol. 40 page 11.

And conveyed to me by H. P. Mc Gee, as Trustee November 2nd, 1918 and recorded in Vol. 51, page 235, R. M. C. Greenville County S. C.
