(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

E. C. Howell All that piece parcel or
 tract of land situated lying and being in Greenville
 County, South Carolina on both sides of Gap
 Creek road having the following miles and bounds
 to wit: Beginning at iron pin in said Gap Creek
 road and running thence N. 13° E. 785 feet to iron
 pin on branch; thence up said branch N. 5° W. 688
 feet to iron pin; thence N. 49 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 583 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to iron
 pin; thence S. 24 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 220.5 feet to iron pin in
 Gap Creek road; thence down the said road S. 56 $\frac{1}{2}$
 E. 256.5 feet to iron pin; thence south 35 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 767
 feet to iron pin in road; thence N. 21 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 1590 feet
 to iron pin on South Tige River below new bridge.
 Corner of tract #4 thence down the meanderings of
 said South Tige River 18.50 feet to iron pin. thence N.
 16 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 2759 feet to iron pin in Gap Creek road the
 beginning corner; containing $2\frac{1}{2}$ acres more or less
 and being tract #5 of the subdivision of the
 A. H. Miller farm as per survey made by
H. S. Brockman, surveyor, Dec. 1918.
