(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

E. C. Howell All that piece parcel or tract of land situated lying and being in Greenville County South Carolina on both sides of Gap Creek road having the following miles and bounds to wit: Beginning at iron pin in said Gap Creek road and running thence N. 13 E. 785 feet, to iron pin on branch; thence up said branch N. 59 W. 688 feet to iron pin; thence S. 49 1/2 W. 583 1/2 feet to iron pin; thence S. 24 W. 220.8 feet to iron pin in Gap Creek road. Thence down the said road S. 56 1/2 E. 256.5 feet to iron pin; thence South 35 1/8 W. 767 feet to iron pin in road; thence S. 21 1/4 W. 1590 feet to iron pin on South Tiger River, below new bridge. Corner of tract #4 thence down the meanderings of said South Tiger River 1550 feet to iron pin. Thence N. 10 3/4 E. 2139 feet to iron pin in Gap Creek road the beginning corner; containing 74 2/3 acres more or less. And being tracts #5 of the subdivision of the A. H. Miller farm as per survey made by N. S. Brockman, surveyor, Dec. 1918.

Also all that piece parcel or tract of land situated lying and being in Greenville and Spartanburg counties, State aforesaid on Gap Creek Road, having following miles and bounds to wit: Beginning at iron pin in Gap Creek road and running thence N. 13 E. 788 feet to iron pin on branch; thence up said branch N. 59 W. 688 feet to iron pin; thence N. 49 1/2 E. 200 feet to a stone; thence N. 28 1/2 W. 977 feet to iron pin; thence S. 45 E. 687 feet to iron pin; Corner of tract #3 thence S. 10 1/4 W. 1607 feet to iron pin in Gap Creek road; thence north 7 1/4 W. 471 feet up said road to beginning corner. Containing twenty seven and one tenth acres (27 1/10) acres more or less. And being tract #2 of the subdivision of the A. H. Miller Farm as per survey made by N. S. Brockman surveyor Dec. 1918.
