(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

J. C. Haley,
 All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the city of Greenville on the west side of South Main Street, and having the following index and bounds, to wit:
 Beginning at a point on line of South Main Street, 30 feet from the southeast corner of lot No. 2 on plot of Markley Realty Company, which plot is recorded in the P. M. C. office for Greenville County, in plot book "C" page 143; thence N. 69-30 W. 110 feet to a point on an alley; thence with line of said alley S. 20-30 W. 36 feet to an iron pin on line of lot no. 6; thence with line of lot no. 6 S. 69-30 E. 110 feet to a point on line of South Main Street; thence with line of said street N. 20-30 E. 36 feet to the beginning corner, and being the same lot of land conveyed to me by J. W. Norwood by his deed dated November 20th 1919 which deed is recorded in the P. M. C. office for Greenville County in deed book 49, page 327.
 Together with one-half interest in the Harrison Ice Cream Building wall, and a one-half interest in the proposed wall to be built by Rush Bros. or their assigns, on the South side of the above lot. That if said proposed wall is not started by March 1st 1920, and completed within a reasonable length of time thereafter, the grantee, or his assigns, may build said wall at the expense of the grantor, or his assigns.
