Beginning at a stone corner of H. T. Knight's thence
N. 51- $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 28.00 to stone; thence N. 71.79 W. 5.70 to stone in road;
thence with road N. 19- $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 4.60 to stone; thence S. 36 E. 4.04
to stone; thence N. 51- $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 8.50 to stone; thence S. 55 E. 23.40
crossing the Laurens County line to stone on branch;
thence down branch to corner in branch, Weimer line;
thence S. 66- $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 6.00 to stone on bank of another branch
corner of Henry T. Knight's thence northwest, along side
of branch, to beginning corner, containing (10.5 less 4.5=)
5.6.2 acres more or less.
